News about your 2018 Annual Meeting of the Membership SAVE THE DATE - TUESDAY JUNE 12TH

BOARD- In an effort to respond to current trends in our industry, our board has decided to downsize from nine directors to seven directors. That being said, there will not be a candidate on the ballot this year for District 2. A director is leaving the board and that position will not be filled in 2018. You will have candidates from Districts 1 and 3 this year. You will be voting for Districts 1, 2 and 3 in 2019.

VOTING OPTIONS- Your board has also decided to offer mail-in and SmartHub on-line voting this year. This is also a trend we are seeing in many cooperatives. We want to give more members access to voting for the directors who run the cooperative. You will also be able to vote in-person at the annual meeting as we have done since 1938. We hope you take advantage of these new voting options this year.

CLARIFICATION- You will NOT be asked to vote on the consolidation at this meeting. The process outlined in the graphic to the right will not be complete before June.

EXPLORE

We always explore options to improve service.

RESEARCH

Independent companies are compiling financial reports.

ANALYZE

Your board analyzes the reports to find benefits and risks.

DIRECTOR VOTE

The board votes on combining the two co-ops.

INFORM

We inform you of the decision made by the directors.

MEMBER VOTE

If the directors vote 'yes,' the members have the final vote on whether to combine the co-ops.

WE ARE HERE. Both boards are reviewing the independently prepared financial reports to determine the value of consolidating. This step in the process could take a few months to complete as there are a lot of integral factors to consider in the reports. Stay tuned as the process continues.
